**INSTRUCTIONS FOR TEAM PRESENTATIONS**

In preparation for the upcoming Design Lab in New Orleans, each Team should develop a brief presentation that captures the Team's progress. Sharing progress will facilitate national community building and cross-pollination. Where synergies exist, the facilitators will also be working together to support collaborative learning among Teams.

Please limit your presentations to **12 minutes including time for discussion**. It is important that presentations keep to schedule as the agenda is full.

As you prepare your presentation, please address the following:

- ✧ What are the Team's goals? How have these goals changed over time? Why?
- ✧ Share Team accomplishments to date.
- ✧ What important lessons have you learned about addressing the social determinants of health (upstream)? What do these lessons suggest about how 'place matters'?
- ✧ What significant challenges lie ahead?
- ✧ Describe your Team's vision for success by the end of 2009. What policies and practices will support this vision?

Your facilitator is available to provide assistance on developing the presentation should this be helpful to your Team.

Special note: for Teams that have already developed a logic model, please do not include your model in this presentation as we will designate a future opportunity for all Teams to share their logic models.

There will be an LCD projector available should your team choose to share slides as a part of your presentation. Please save your PowerPoint presentation to a flash drive. Should you have handouts to accompany your presentation, please bring at least 90 copies. *The program staff will not be able to make copies for you on site.*
